

1. **Amount**
 - a) Eight \$1,000.00 bursaries will be awarded annually to students in the community attending post-secondary. Four \$1,000.00 bursaries will be awarded to members and four \$1,000.00 to non-members; providing that at least eight candidates satisfy the eligibility criteria.

2. **Eligibility**

Member applicants must be:

 - a) A member of Motor City Community Credit Union Ltd. for one year prior to application;
 - b) Enrolled in a degree or diploma program at a recognized post-secondary institution;

Non-Member applicants must be:

 - a) Enrolled in a degree or diploma program at a recognized post-secondary institution
 - b) Become a member of MCCCCU upon receipt of \$1,000.00 award.

Note: One bursary per application per year will be awarded, although candidates are eligible to receive bursaries each year of post-secondary enrolment.

3. **Selection Criteria**
 - a) Applicants will be evaluated by the Motor City Community Credit Union Ltd. Scholarship Committee with emphasis given to community involvement and financial need.

4. **Awarding the Bursaries**
 - a) Awarding of the Bursaries is contingent upon confirmation by the Scholarship Committee of the applicant's attendance at a post-secondary institution;
 - b) **Bursaries are awarded to the successful candidates at the Motor City Community Credit Union Ltd. Annual General Meeting (AGM) to be held July 10, 2019. Monies will be presented at the AGM.**

5. **Application Document Requirements**

Applications must include:

 - a) An official transcript of grades;
 - b) Motor City Student Bursary Application Form;
 - c) A statement describing the applicant's community involvement;
 - d) Any other information which the applicant may wish the Scholarship Committee to consider.

The Motor City Community Credit Union Ltd. Scholarship Committee reserves the right to ask for verification of any information and will interview candidates either in person or by telephone.

6. **Application Submission**
 - a) Completed applications containing the documentation requested as stated in item five (5) of this information sheet must be received by **May 1, 2019**
